## Planning for the Prevention of Sexual Violence

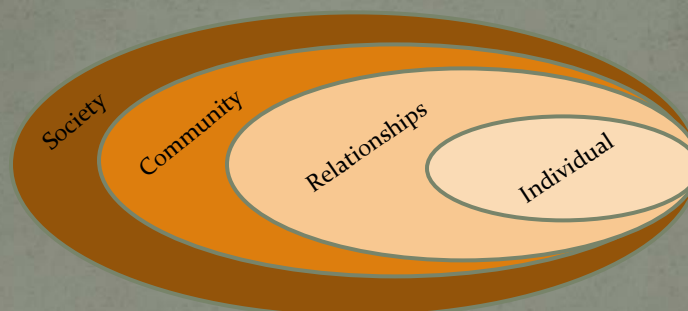
October 2007...Public Health Planning Model



Sexual Violence is a physical and/or emotional assault that is sexual in nature.

Primary Prevention of Sexual Violence decreases risk factors and increases protective factors through integration of the socio-ecological model.

## Narrowing Data

Physically forced to have sexual intercourse when they did not want to	3	3	3	9
Having someone use force or threat of force to have sex with them as a result of drinking	3	3	3	9
Sexual penetration against their will	3	3	3	9
Sexual touching against their will	3	2	3	8
Verbal threats for sex against their will	3	2	3	8
Attempted sexual penetration against their will	3	2	3	8
Sexually abusive relationship	2	3	3	8
Incidents of sexual harassment, sexual battery, sex offenses in Wyoming schools	2	3	3	8
Sexual assault reported to Wyosafe	2	3	2	7

## Recommendations

- Target is 12-24 year olds
- Statewide effort
- Start interventions early across time and ages
- Promote healthy sexuality
- Partners
- Expand knowledge (protective factors, community readiness survey)

## Sexual Violence in Wyoming *is not...*

- Just in one location
- Strangers jumping out of bushes
- All adults on children
- All adults over 25
- Defined by characteristics of victim, perpetrator, or precursor
- Inmate-on-inmate in Wyoming prisons
- Usually reported as domestic violence
